Character Background

A few months ago you were hunting river rats when you spotted a few tents. You snuck in for a closer look. You find a series of cages. In one of them you found a captive Kobold. He told you that he knows the location of some yummy HUMAN BABIES! If you freed him, he promised to take you to them and help you grab them. You stole the keys from a sleeping guard and freed your new friend. You both raced into the surrounding woods. As night falls your friend started to exhibit strange behavior including awkward clucking sounds and sudden head jerks. You entered a clearing in the forest. The glow of the full moon illuminated you. You witnessed your partner transform into a huge chicken. You raced from the clearing seeking a safe place to hide. But it was already too late. The chicken quickly caught up with you and began pecking at you. At some point you blacked out from the pain. When you awoke your fur was missing in spots. You were bleeding from cuts on your battered body. It does not take long for you realize you have changed. **YOU ARE A WERECHICKEN!**

Goals

You have dedicated your life to the holy priesthood of Vor, the Big Red Angry God. Vor is always watching and is known to smite his followers.

- Be faithful to Vor
- Protect Archibald[#26]
- Escape the plane alive

Enemies

You do not have any friends among the Humans and Elves whose livestock you consume as a werechicken.

Allies

Shatus[#18] is the local pipeweed merchant. So, he spends a lot of time mocking his Elven competition. He is a filthy blasphemer but knows quite a bit about Elves.

Puscag[#22] is also a faithful servant to the Big Red Angry God.

You possess a Magpie named Archibald[#26]. He is a supernatural totem that grants you additional abilities. If you lose favor with your totem by, say, trying to cook and eat him, then you will lose these abilities.

Items

Magpie named Archibald[#26] (totem)
Holy Symbol
Corn

Special Abilities

Beloved of Vor: You can channel the anger of Vor against the wicked by pointing out their sins to Vor. The victim must tear up 2 cards. You also have to tear up a card because getting Vor's attention is always a bad idea.

Hen-Pecked: Cuts do not heal even with magic.

Change Form: You can transform into a werechicken after ten minutes of contemplative meditation or if your hit points are 3 or below. You will instantly transform back to Kobold form if you smell the flowery smell of Hyacinth. Otherwise, you can transform back after remaining still for ten minutes.

WERECHICKEN:

10 Hit Points

Talon Attack: 3 Points

+Evade

+Leap

Talk with Chickens: You can communicate with chickens including werechickens. This sounds like clucking to anyone listening. You can also talk to Archibald. He is very opinionated and will nag you shamelessly. The trick, really, is to get him to shut up.

Chicken Feet: Your feet become razor sharp talons that give 3 points of damage. This also gives you the ability to run quickly and to leap. This costs one card.
