Special Abilities

Rules Lawyer: It is your duty to spot other players breaking rules and doing things of which their characters would not have knowledge. If you catch a player in an infraction, very loudly demand a bribe of one card to keep from calling the Mayor.

Gray Portrait: The portrait makes it impossible for you to die of old age. It also makes you immune from the effects of fire, cold, poison and magic. You are not indestructible, however, and will suffer the effects of damage from combat. If the portrait is destroyed, you immediately die.

The most important thing you have to ask yourself before doing any task is: how will my fur look afterwards?
