Special Abilities

Name	Description	Characters
Beam Me Up	You can teleport short distances. You will drop anything you are carrying when you do. This costs one card.	#24
Beloved of Vor	You can channel the anger of Vor against the wicked by pointing out their sins to Vor. The victim must tear up 2 cards. You also have to tear up a card because getting Vor's attention is always a bad idea.	#11, #22
Change Form	You can transform into a werechicken after ten minutes of contemplative meditation or if your hit points are 3 or below. You will instantly transform back to Kobold form if you smell the flowery smell of Hyacinth. Otherwise, you can transform back after remaining still for ten minutes.	#10, #11
Chicken Feet	Your feet become razor sharp talons that give 3 points of damage. This also gives you the ability to run quickly and to leap. This costs one card.	#10, #11
Cup Runneth Over	You can summon water by cupping your hands. As long as your hands are cupped water will continue to flow. The water will overflow your hands and can be collected in pitchers or other containers. This costs one card.	#17
Dagger of Chicken Slaying	If a chicken hits you and you lose a card, then you can take a card at random from the chicken and give it one of your crappy ones.	#12
Golden Egg	You can lay a shiny, golden egg. This costs one card.	#25
Gray Portrait	The portrait makes it impossible for you to die of old age. It also makes you immune from the effects of fire, cold, poison and magic. If the portrait is destroyed, you immediately die. Once you die, the canvas will become blank again.	#16
Hen-Pecked	Cuts do not heal even with magic.	#10, #11
Interface with Technology	You have a probe that allows you to interface with new technology. This costs one	#24
Iron Will	Your faith in Vor grants you immunity from fear and cowardice. Nobody can turn you or stare you down.	#22
King's Kin	You are related to King Torg (ALL HAIL KING TORG!). If you catch someone not saying "All Hail King Torg!" when they should be, they have to give you the card they lose for breaking the ALL HAIL KING TORG rule.	#14
Levitate	You can levitate a short distance and carry a light load. This requires one card.	#23
Magic Missile	Man, this trick is so old it has whiskers. You cast a missile that does one damage if it hits. This costs you one card.	#19

Name	Description	Characters
Magpie's Pie	You cause a pie to appear in a cloud of smoke. The pie containing 1-6 live crows that immediately attack the first Kobold to touch the pie. This costs two cards.	#26
Nauseous Cloud	You can summon a cloud of nauseous fumes that temporarily stun every living creature within five feet. Your targets can sacrifice a card in order to flee the cloud without being stunned. This costs two cards.	#20
Old Kobold Mind Trick	You may select a Kobold with five steps of yourself. If the target fails their draw, you may give them a command. A command must be a simple statement (that is obviously not self-destructive). Your target can sacrifice a card to ignore your command. This costs one card.	#17, #19
Pipeweed Vendor	Once a Kobold accepts a Pipeweed card, they are instantly hooked! They cannot accept a Sweetleaf card. They cannot discard, destroy or trade the Pipeweed away. The only way to get rid of it is to sell it back to you.	#18
Plague Brood	You will lay 1-6 eggs that will instantly grow to an unnatural size and hatch plague-ridden chickens. This costs two cards.	#25
Poultry Awareness	You can give you the general direction of other chickens including werechickens. To others this appears to be a cute chicken dance. This costs one card.	#25, #26
Psy-Crow	You can manipulate the mind of one Kobold. Your eyes will grow red when the psychic link is established with the target. Once you are engaged, you are unable to respond until the link is broken. Although you cannot respond, you can still hear somebody speaking to you. This costs two cards.	#26
Restor's Spell of Somnolence	You may select a Kobold with line of sight. If that Kobold fails their draw, they "fall asleep" for five minutes. The player must lie down with their hand folded under their head. They may wake up if they are bitten, kicked, poked, pushed, prodded, probed, smothered in a secret sauce, etc. This costs one card.	#17, #19
Ring of Giant Growth	You immediately grow to twice your height, twice your weight and do twice the damage. This ability costs 2 cards.	#15
Ring of Human Speaking	You can understand 6 human words. Write them down on the back of the ring's card. You may also one additional word: Beer.	#21
Robo-wrench	You can build a robot. This costs 4 cards and 2 beers.	#23
Ruby Laser	Your eyes can emit a laser beam. The intensity of the beam depends on the number of beers you consume. This costs 2-6 beers.	#23

Name	Description	Characters
Rules Lawyer	It is your duty to spot other players breaking rules and doing things of which their characters would not have knowledge. If you catch a player in an infraction, very loudly demand a bribe of one card to keep from calling the Mayor.	#16
Sands of Time	You can summon an hourglass filled with sand. If you turn the hourglass over and set it down, time will freeze for two minutes. Once the two minutes is up, time resumes its normal flow. The hourglass will break and leave behind a pile of sand. This costs you two cards.	#19
Short Order Cook	Any Chicken, Baby or Kobold meal prepared by you heals +2 cards when it is eaten.	#13, #18
Sneaky Little Bastard	By folding your arms across your chest in a X formation, you become invisible. Other player have to pretend you are not there. If somebody offers you a card, you cannot refuse and must uncross your arms becoming visible again. This costs one card.	#12, #21
Stare Down	By staring into the eyes of any creature, you can cause the target to flee in terror.	#10
Sweetleaf Vendor	Once a Kobold accepts a Sweetleaf card, they are instantly hooked! They cannot accept a Pipeweed card. They cannot discard, destroy or trade the Sweetleaf away. The only way to get rid of it is to sell it back to you	#13
Talk with Chickens	You can communicate with chickens including werechickens. This sounds like clucking to anyone listening.	#10, #11, #25, #26
Tear It Up	You have the ability to break any non-living object down into its component parts. You give it a swift kick and work at it with your can opener. This costs one card.	#20
Tractor Beam	You can shoot a beam and pull a medium-size object, like a Kobold for example, to you. This costs one card.	#24
Turn Chickens	You are able to turn chicken by holding up your holy symbol to Vor. This costs one	#22
Vain	Kobolds may smell like wet dogs but that does not prevent you from looking good! Do you know how much effort it takes to chase river rats and still look like you stepped out of a Carroll's Bay catalog? You are so worth it, baby! The most important you have to ask yourself before doing any task is: how will my fur look afterwards?	#16
Veteran Kobold	You can force another Kobold to either exchange weapons with you. If they refuse they must give you a card. You may only do this once per character. This does not work on other veteran Kobolds.	#14, #15
